### ROAD ACCIDENTS - INITIAL ACTIONS

The initial actions of the first officers at the scene of a road accident are often crucial. The very first action must be taken is the protection of the locus for the safety of personnel and the avoidance of secondary accidents. Consideration must be given to the prevailing visibility, nature of the road and the expected volume of traffic. Effective use must be made of marked Police vehicles, cones, lights and signs.

Advance warning signs e.g. "POLICE - ACCIDENT" should be placed sufficiently far from each side of the locus to give motorists ample warning of the incident, and on the approach to any hill crests or bends near the locus.

The protection of the locus also serves to preserve evidence which may be lost if vehicles continue to drive through. The position of the vehicles, tyre marks, and debris are often the only source of information as to how an accident happened and MUST be preserved until examined by trained personnel.

If circumstances allow, all the actions described overleaf should be considered, and these circumstances will dictate the priorities.
