PROCEDURE ON ARREST RIGHTS OF ACCUSED

Immediately on arrest, or as soon as practicable thereafter, police officer must:

- (a) administer formal caution;
- (b) inform accused of reason for arrest;
- (c) take accused to suitable police station;
- (d) at police station read rights to accused –
 - (i) 16 years or over: re solicitor and one named person
 - (ii) under 16 years: re solicitor and parent/guardian;
- (e) carry out set procedure and complete necessary forms.

CAUTION

"I am going to charge you, but before I do so I must caution you that you do not need to say anything in answer to the charge, but anything you do say will be noted and may be used in evidence. Do you understand? [await reply]. The charge against you is that you did [specify wording of charge]. Do you understand the charge? [await reply]. Have you anything to say?"

STATEMENT RE SOLICITOR

"You are entitled to have intimation sent to a solicitor that you require his professional assistance and he will be informed of the place to which you are to be taken for appearance in court. Such solicitor will also be entitled to have a private interview with you before you are brought before the court and, if you are dealt with on solemn procedure, to be present at any judicial examination.

The Sheriff or Justice also has power to delay such judicial examination for a period not exceeding 48 hours from the time of your arrest, in order to allow time for the attendance of such solicitor".

STATEMENT RE NAMED PERSON

"You are also entitled to have intimation of your custody and of the place where you are being held sent to a person reasonably named by you".

STATEMENT RE PARENT/GUARDIAN

"I am obliged to send intimation of your custody and of the place where you are being held to your parent/guardian".
