

FINANCE

On 21.3.88, £67,580 paid into victim's Royal Bank of Scotland account by D & D Carruthers. Same day shows debit of £33,000 and a cheque drawn for £36,310.

On 31.1.94, victim bought Honda motor car from Doonfoot Garage for £15,400 - how did she pay?

On 13.7.95 her Royal Bank of Scotland account was credited with £14,883 from unknown source.

In March 1995, victim withdrew £7,000 from Halifax account.

On 24.7.95 she withdrew Royal Bank of Scotland cheque for £7,690.37, both these transactions possibly for extension to her house.

On 4.5.96 she sold her Honda motor car to Lang Bros., Gatehead. They paid her £9,400 by cheque - into which account?

Found at locus - Alliance and Leicester transfer slip showing investment of £20,397.27 on 30.1.95.

WILLIAM CAMPBELL (47), 28 Western Road, Galston (cousin).

5'8", medium, light brown receding hair, moustache, constantly wears glasses, wears hat.

HUGH MILLOY (49), 25 Goatfoot Road, Galston.

5'10", stocky, dark brown/grey hair, balding.

Both use Ford Transit D355 KMS, red colour with blue roof.

Isabella Munro (N72) 42 Irvine Road, describes male 5'8", lean build, 30-40, swarthy complexion, dark hair, usually wore a blue bonnet. Had collie dog and large royal blue van. Had a teenage male with him on occasions.

Mary Gemmell (N16) S6B, 45 Irvine Road, describes male, 50 years, grey/brown hair. Other male was younger ^{not seen by witness} in blue van, possibly a Transit.

Annie Henry (S42) (N107) describes two gardeners who arrived in a dark red van and were 'iffy' looking.

CARS

Mary Gemmell (N16) speaks of red car being parked in victim's runway within last six months, sometimes overnight.

Fiona Maxwell (N35) speaks of red car in driveway before Christmas.

This would appear not to be victim's Honda which she sold in May 1996.

William Hannah speaks of seeing victim and after described male in a deep red metallic car - no dates specified. He was of the opinion the male lived with deceased. The last time he saw male was three months ago.

Male, white, 5'2"-5'3", stocky, 12 stone, short, tidy, grey hair, clean shaven, polite (S56)

Catherine Hannah (S59) also speaks of seeing this male regularly - last time 3-4 months ago.

She doesn't recall seeing a car, however, describes male as 50 years, stout with short, grey hair, tidy.

VAN - DIRTY BROWN/MAROON

Seen outside deceased's home December 1996 by Isabel Munro, 42 Irvine Road. No further information.

VAN - WHITE 'VANETTE'

Seen in grounds of Annanhill Primary 0240 hours Wednesday 8 January 1997 - S30 Agnes Cameron, 54 Irvine Road. No other sightings.

UNIDENT FEMALE - N165

Seen by Andrew Caldow N

Female, almost 6'0", brown trousers, white woollen top with three or four horizontal stripes, possibly red in colour, dark trousers or skirt, shoulder length dark brown hair, well built.

This female was seen at victim's porch approximately 1015 Tuesday 7 January 1997.
